3. Which CIA campus are you currently attending?






5. Which program are you currently enrolled in?











16. To what extent do you believe tobacco use at the CIA is a cause for concern and should be addressed?










21. To what extent do you believe vape pen/electronic vaping device use at the CIA is a cause for concern and should be addressed?























54. In the state of New York, what components make up the definition of affirmative consent?





Off campus - Dating violence (sexual or physical abuse by an intimate social partner or acquaintance)








Would you know how to? - Report the incident to campus safety/security






Would you know how to? - Report the incident to a Residence Life staff member




Would you be likely to? - Report the incident to a Residence Life staff member




Would you know how to? - Report the incident to a faculty member






Would you know how to? - Seek confidential counseling from an on-campus counselor/therapist










Would you know how to? - Seek support and advocacy services from off-campus resources (i.e. Rape Crisis Center)








Would you know how to? - Report the incident to off-campus law enforcement






Would you know how to? - Take steps to preserve evidence (i.e. not shower)


