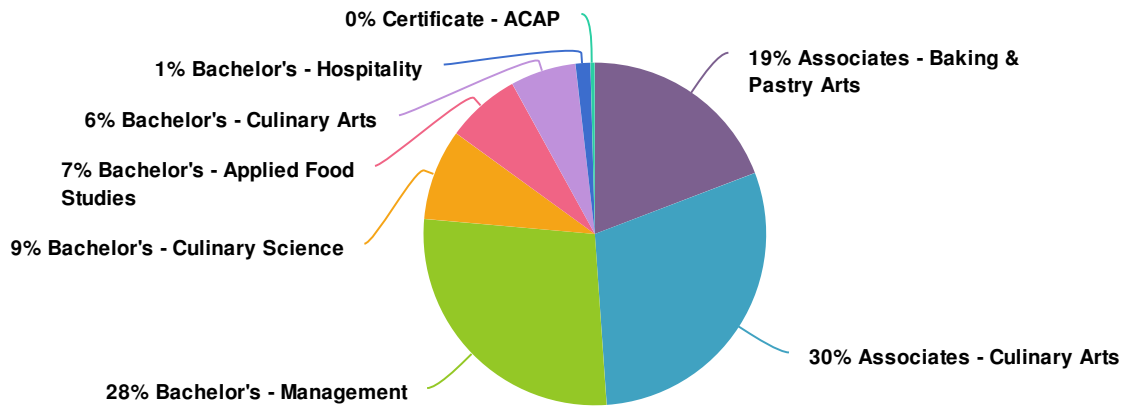

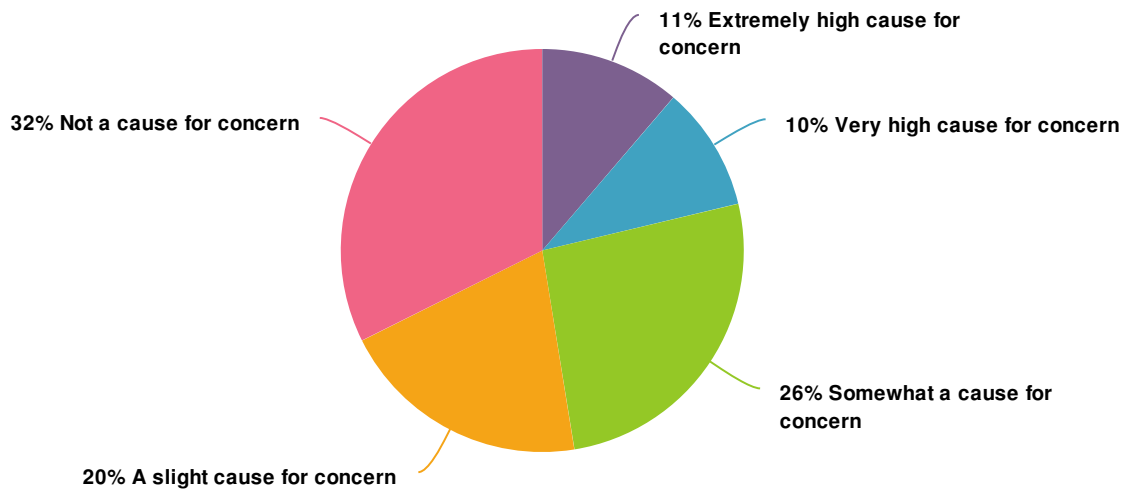
15. How many packs of cigarettes do you smoke in a typical week?






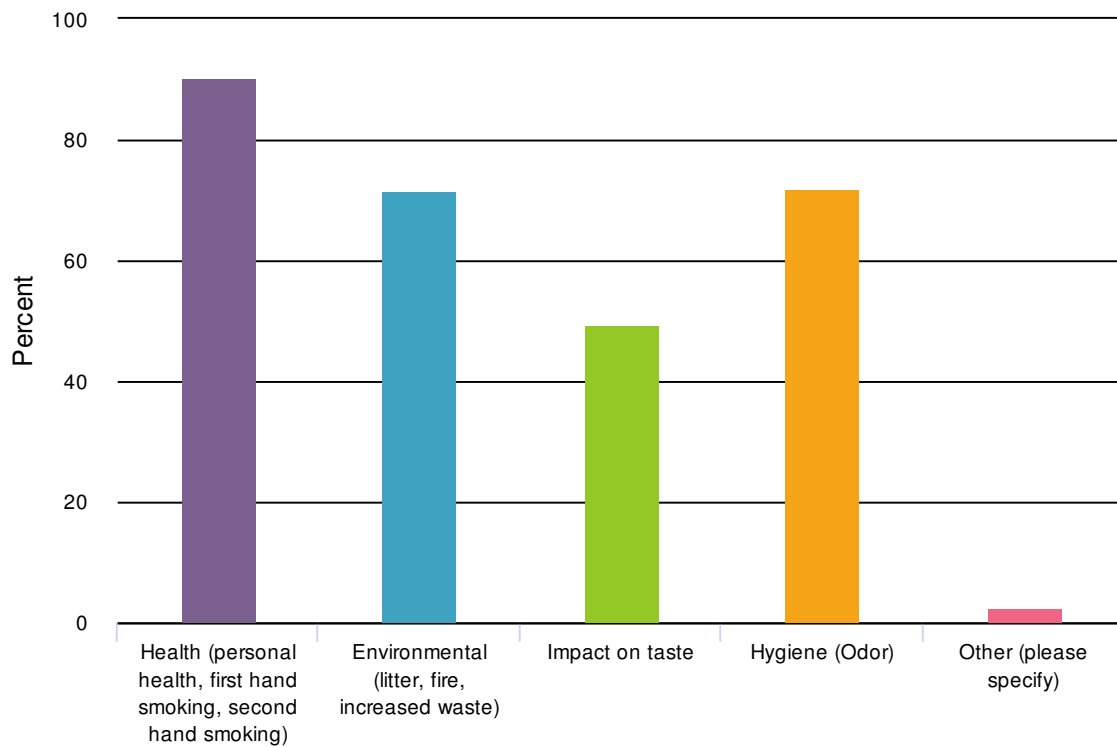
16. To what extent do you believe tobacco use at the CIA is a cause for concern and should be addressed?

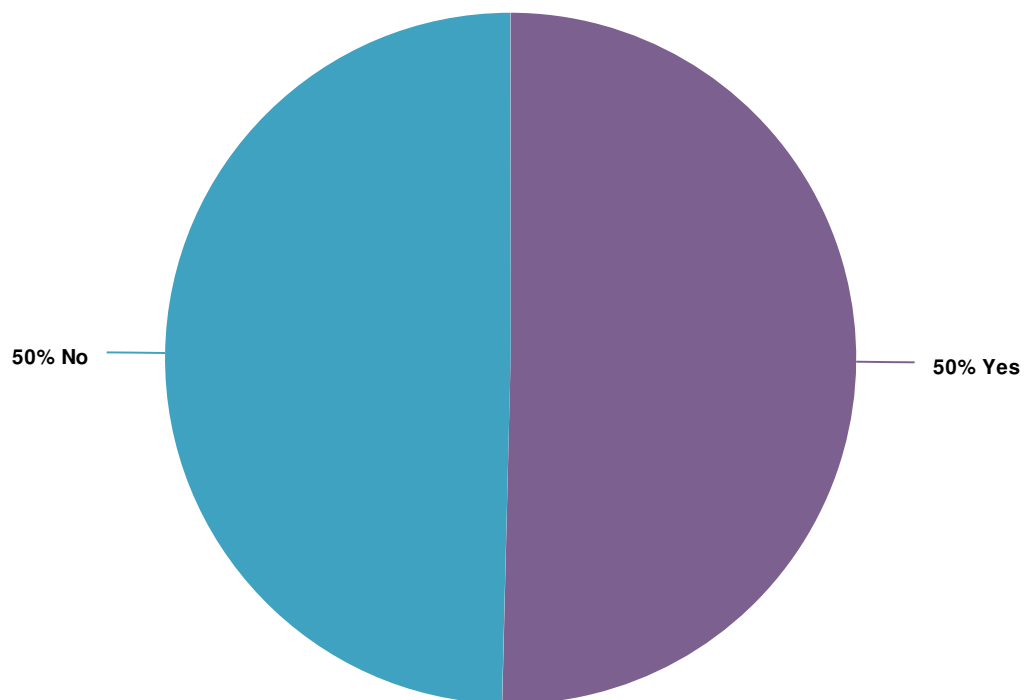
17. Whether you smoke or not, what specific concerns regarding tobacco use do you have? (check all that apply)

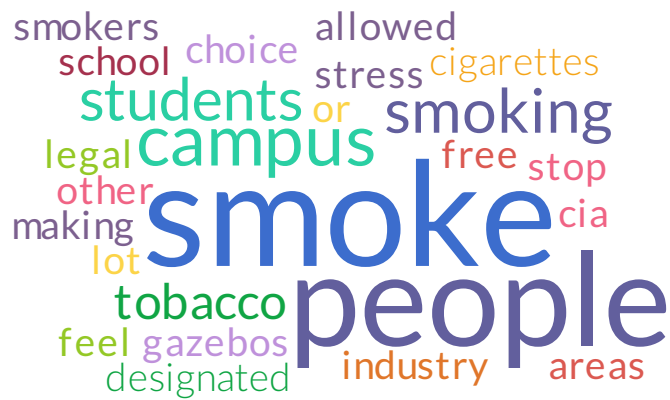

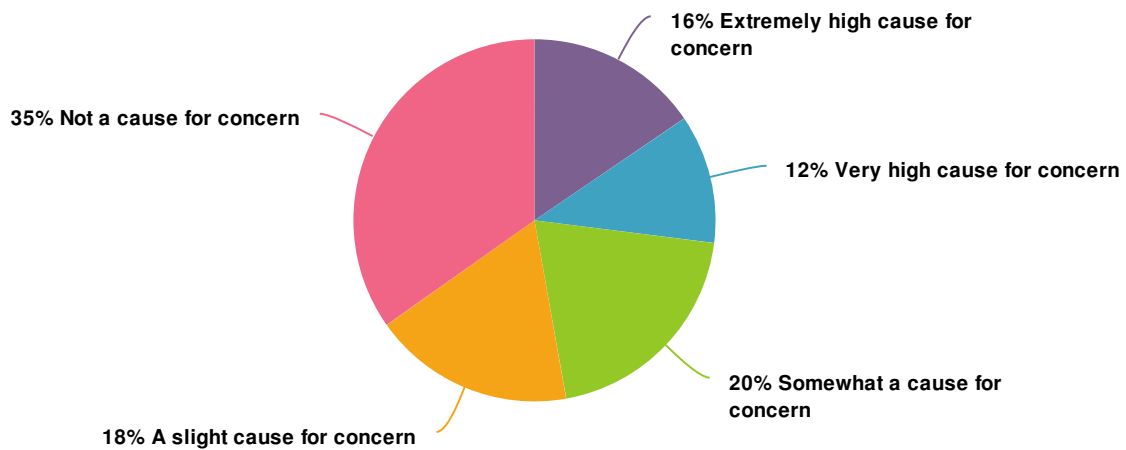

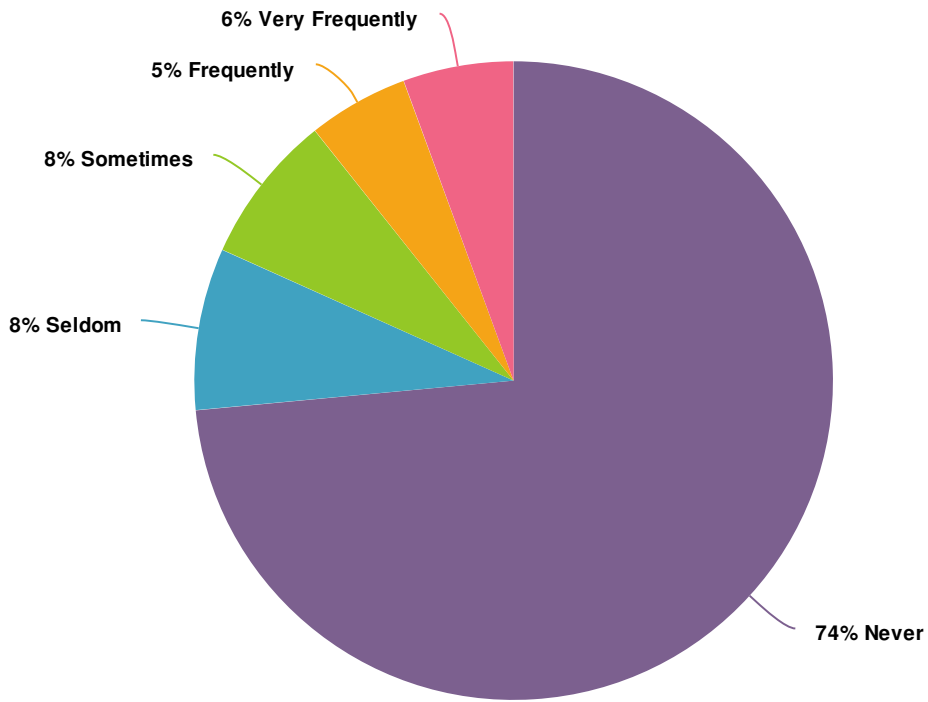


21. To what extent do you believe vape pen/electronic vaping device use at the CIA is a cause for concern and should be addressed?

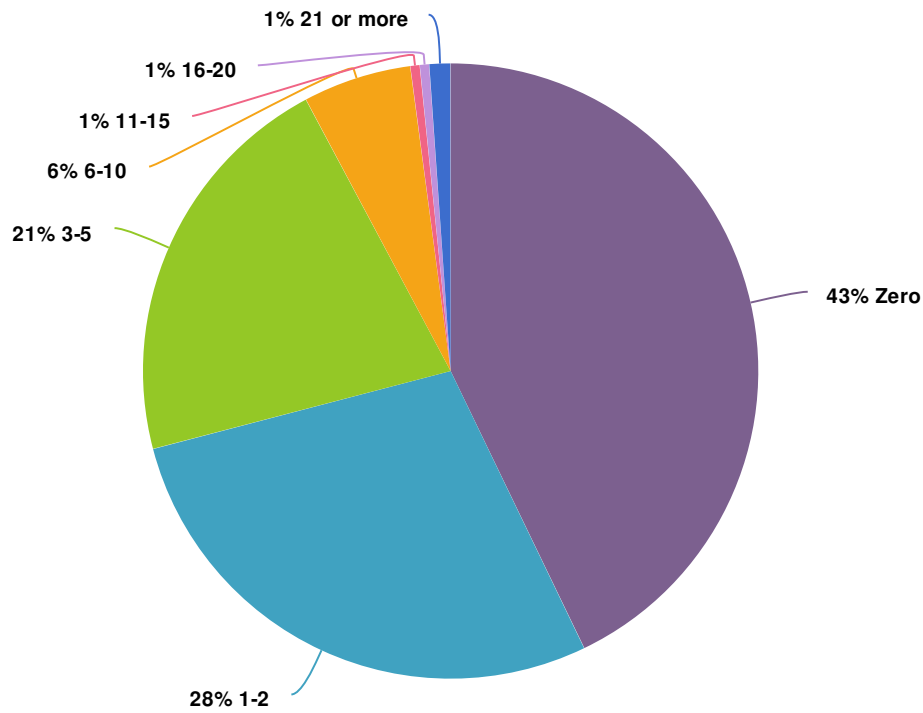

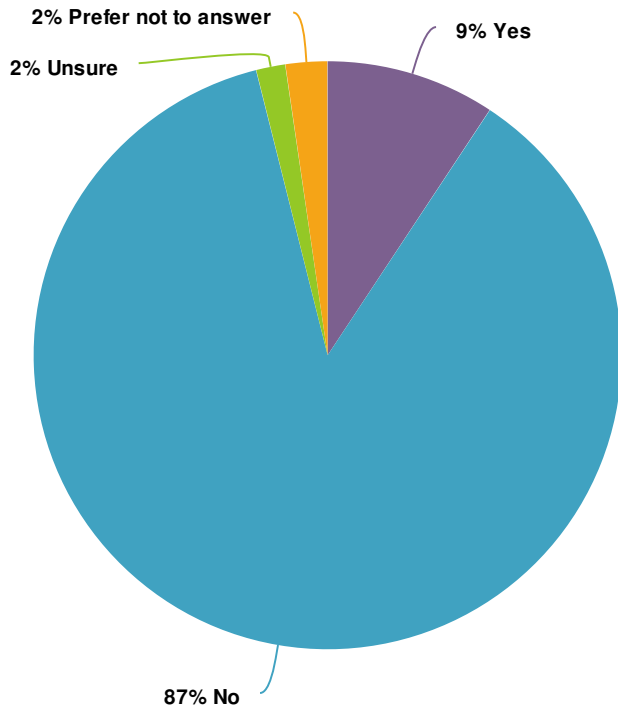
48. While at the CIA, have you ever engaged in a sexual act with someone who was under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs?

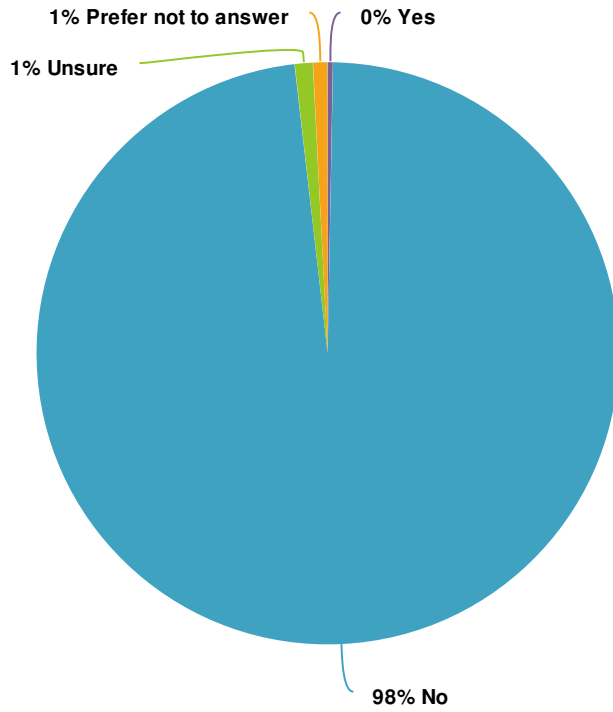
49. While at the CIA, have you ever engaged in a sexual act with someone while you were under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs?

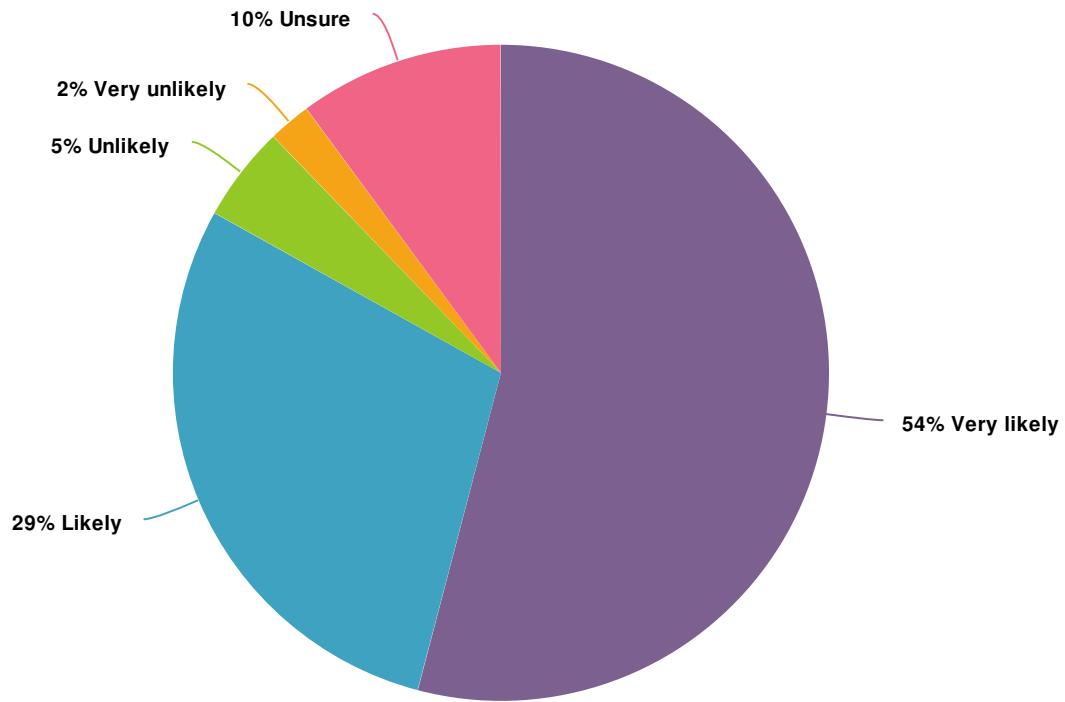
50. While at the CIA, have you ever engaged in a sexual act with someone who did not give clear consent (yes) to engage in the sexual act?

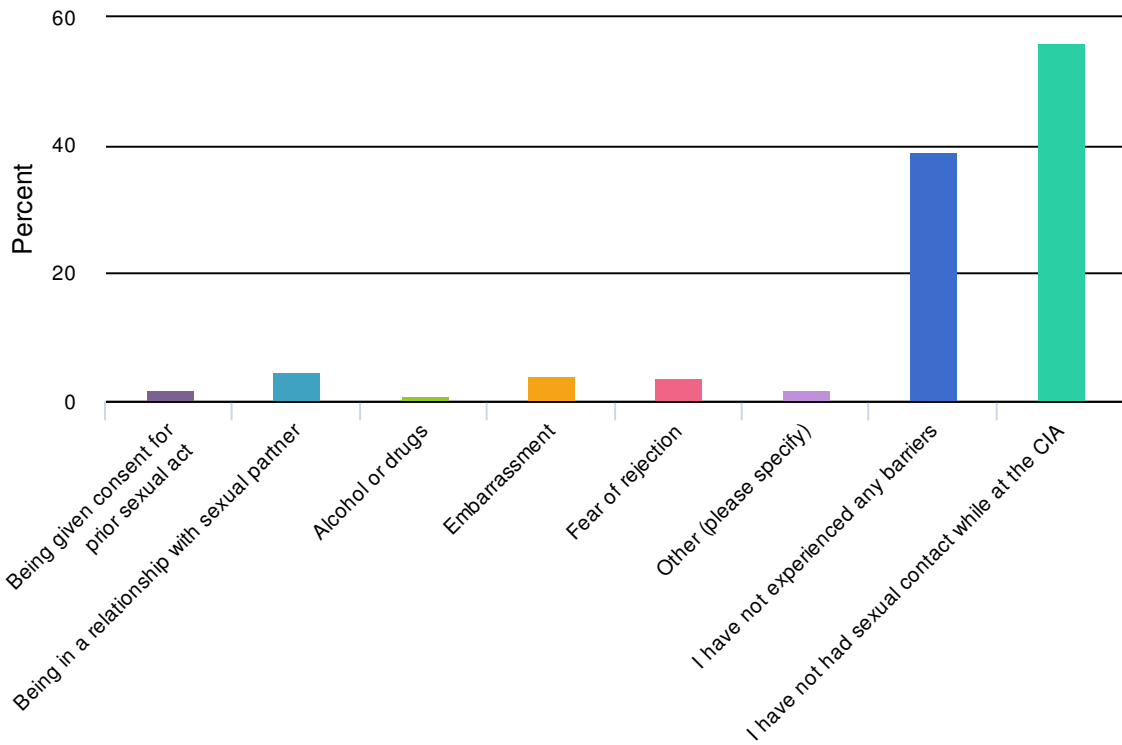

51. Hypothetically, how likely would you be to have a conversation with your sexual partner about your intentions prior to engaging in a sexual act?



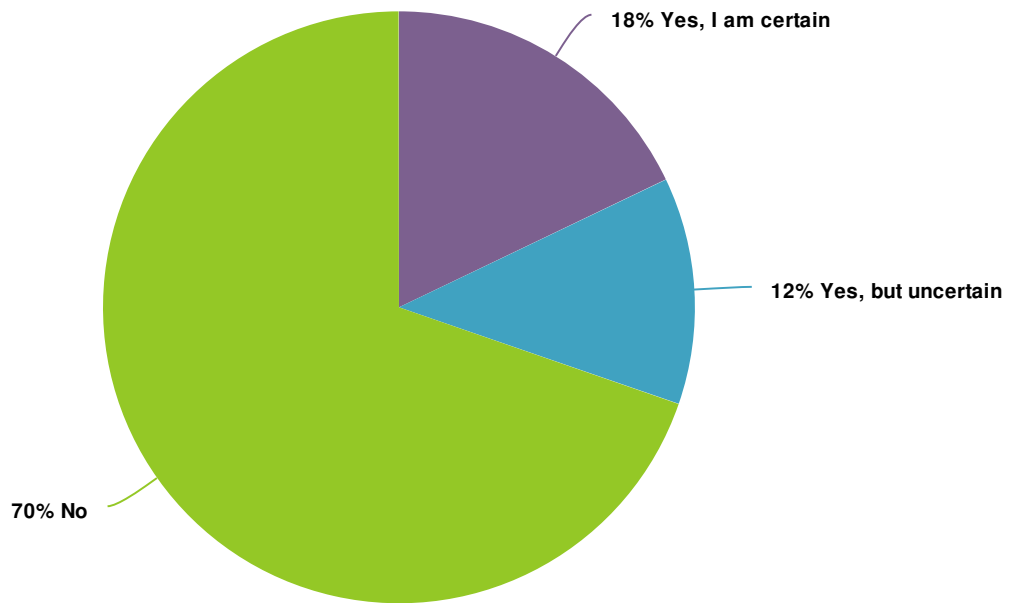

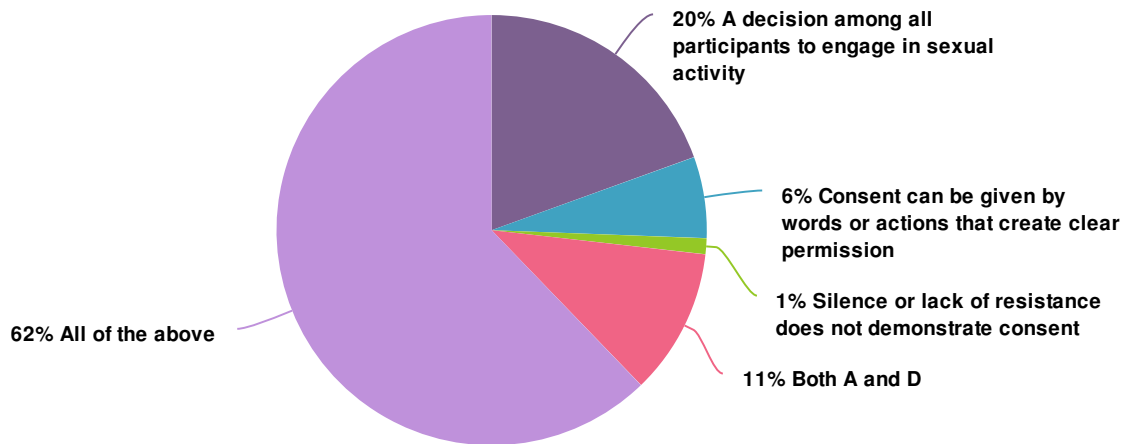

54. In the state of New York, what components make up the definition of affirmative consent?

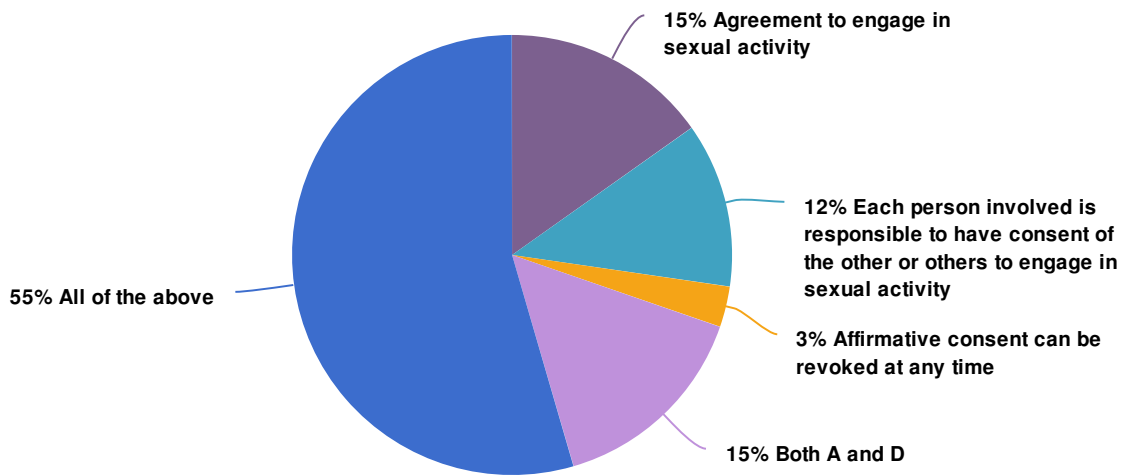

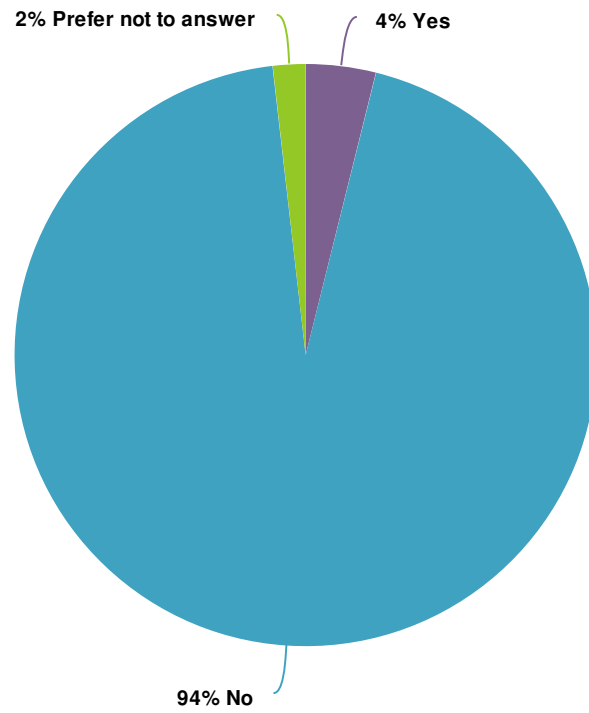

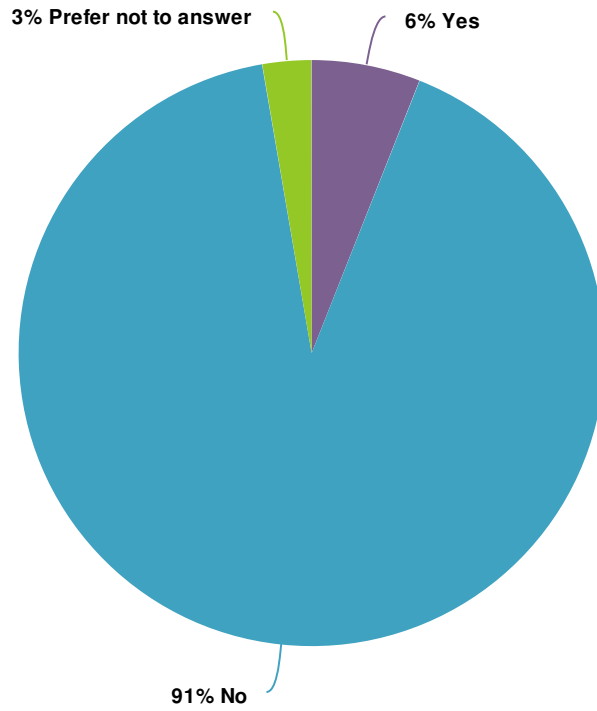

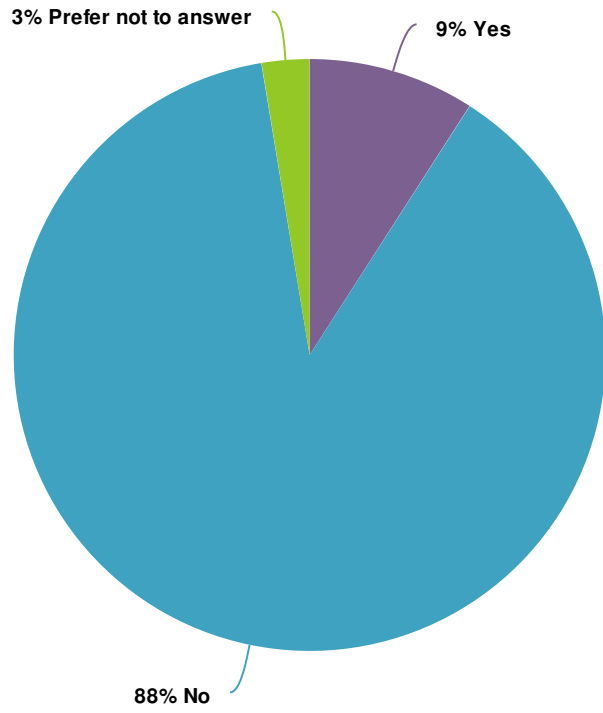
Off campus - Sexual assault (rape, fondling, groping)

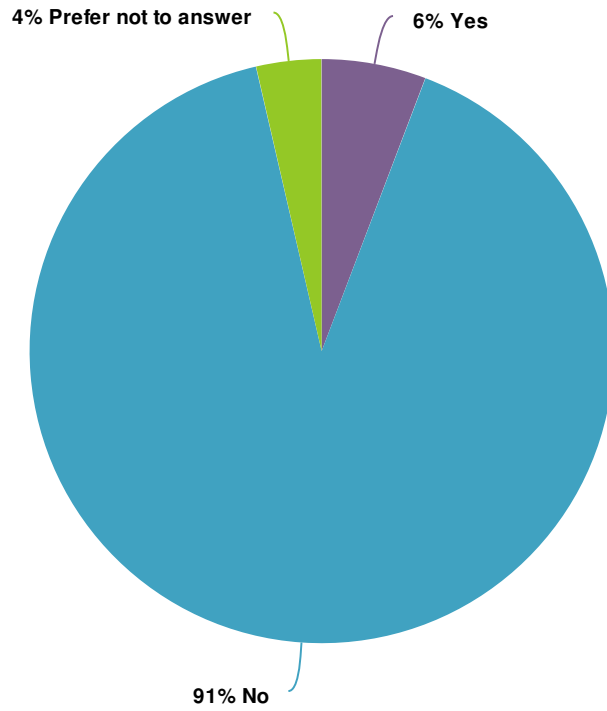
On campus - Stalking (electronic or in person)

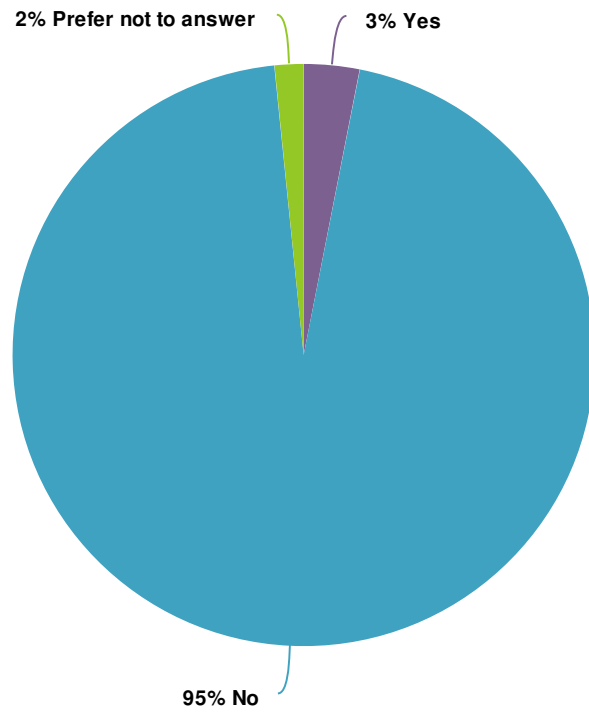
Off campus - Stalking (electronic or in person)

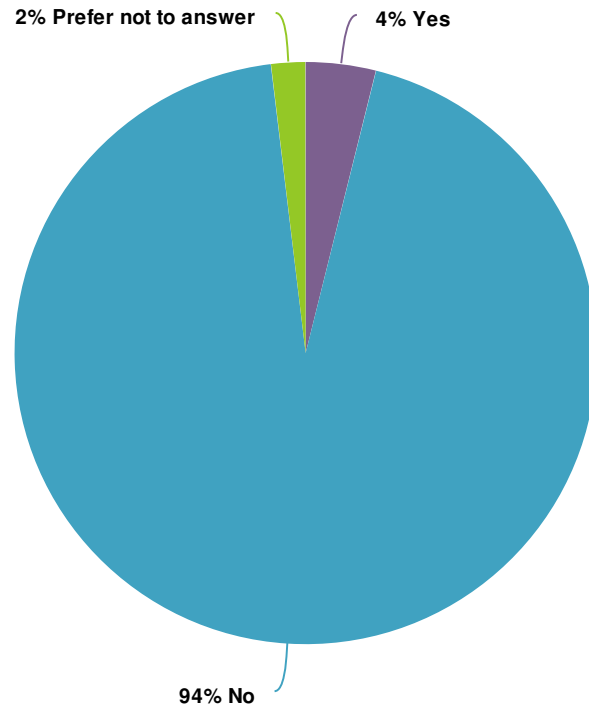
On campus - Dating violence (sexual or physical abuse by an intimate social partner or acquaintance)

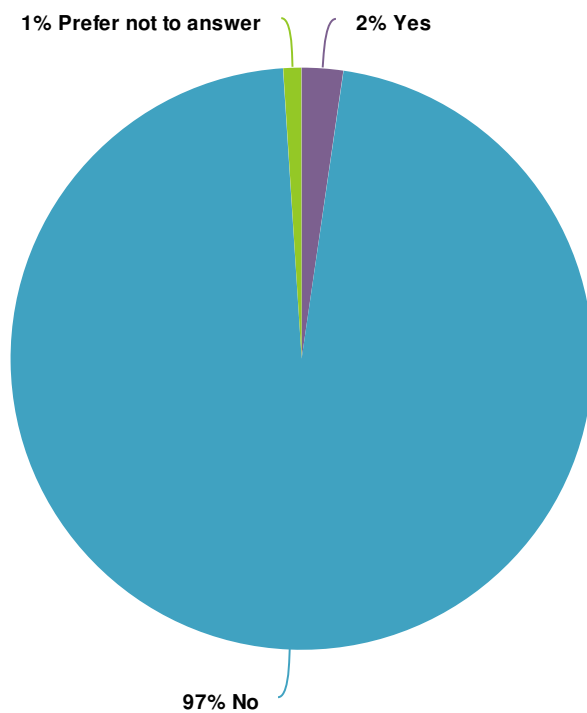

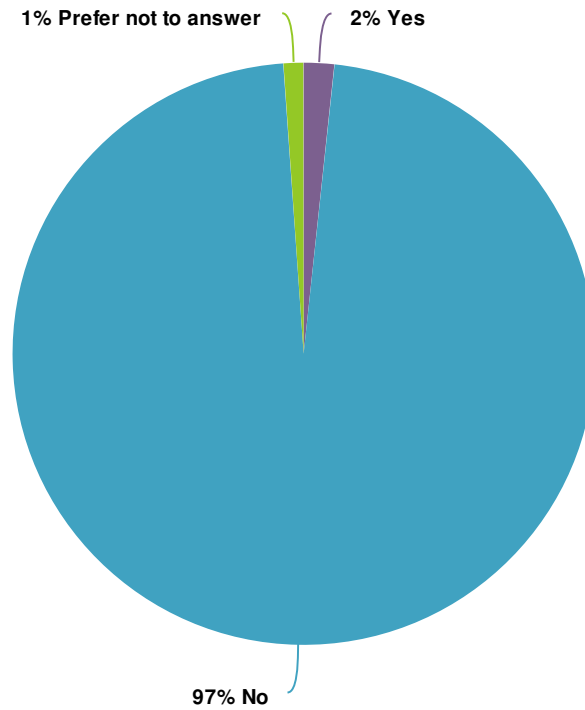
On campus - Domestic violence (sexual or physical abuse by an intimate partner or spouse with shared living situations)

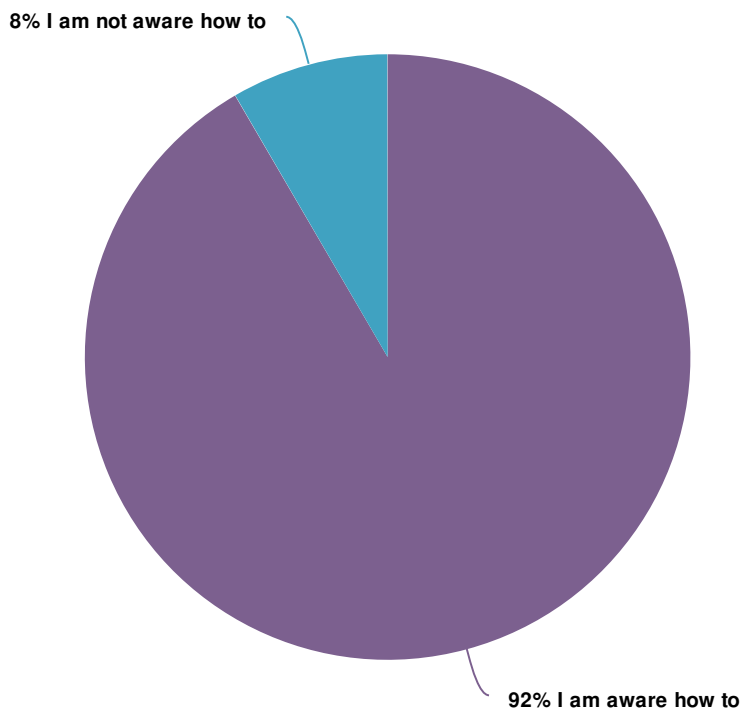

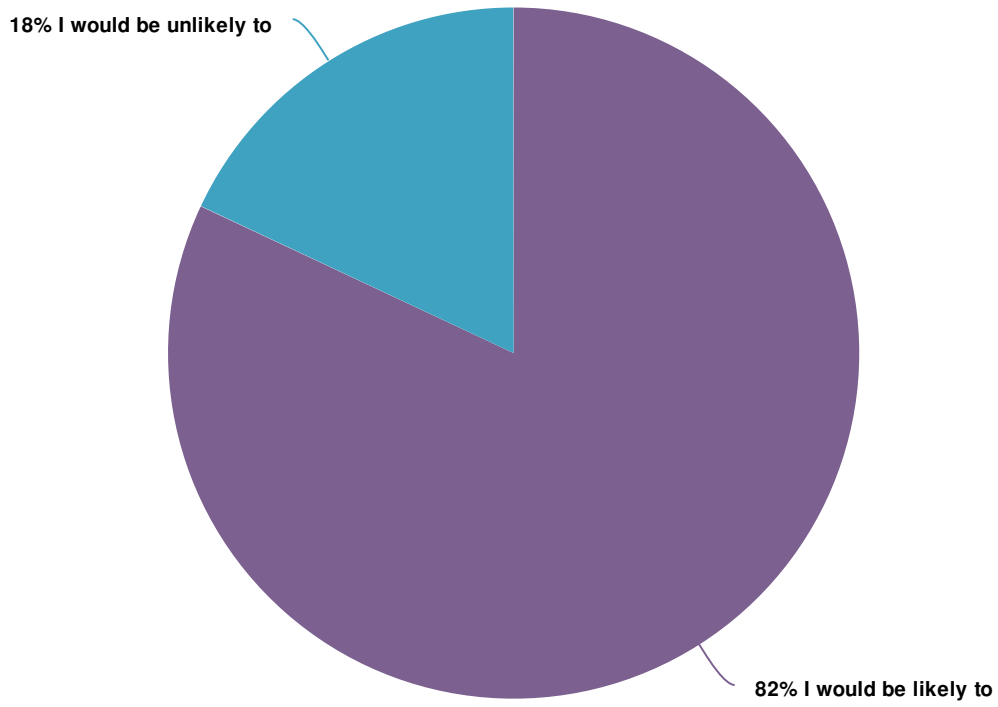


Would you know how to? - Report the incident to campus safety/security

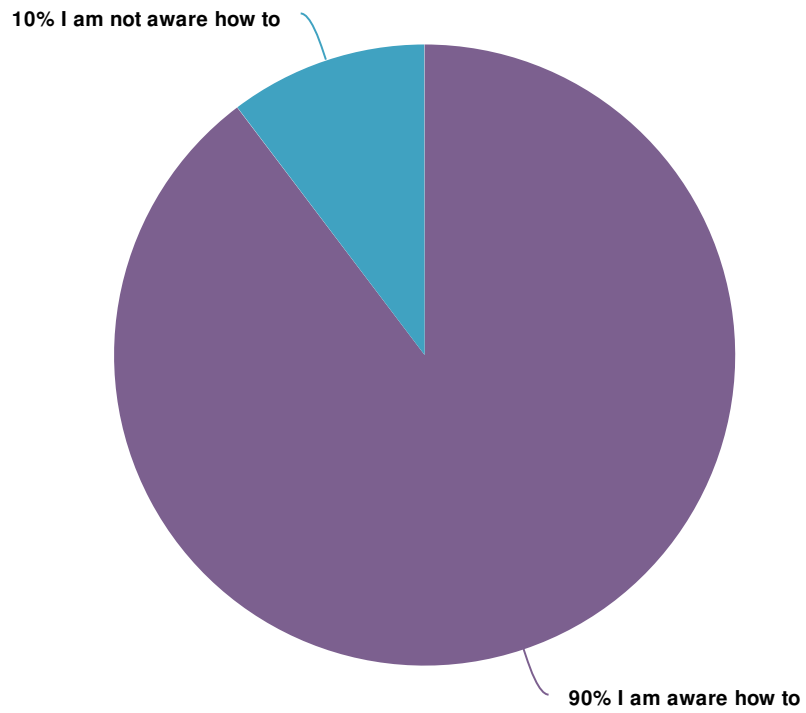
Would you be likely to? - Report the incident to campus safety/security

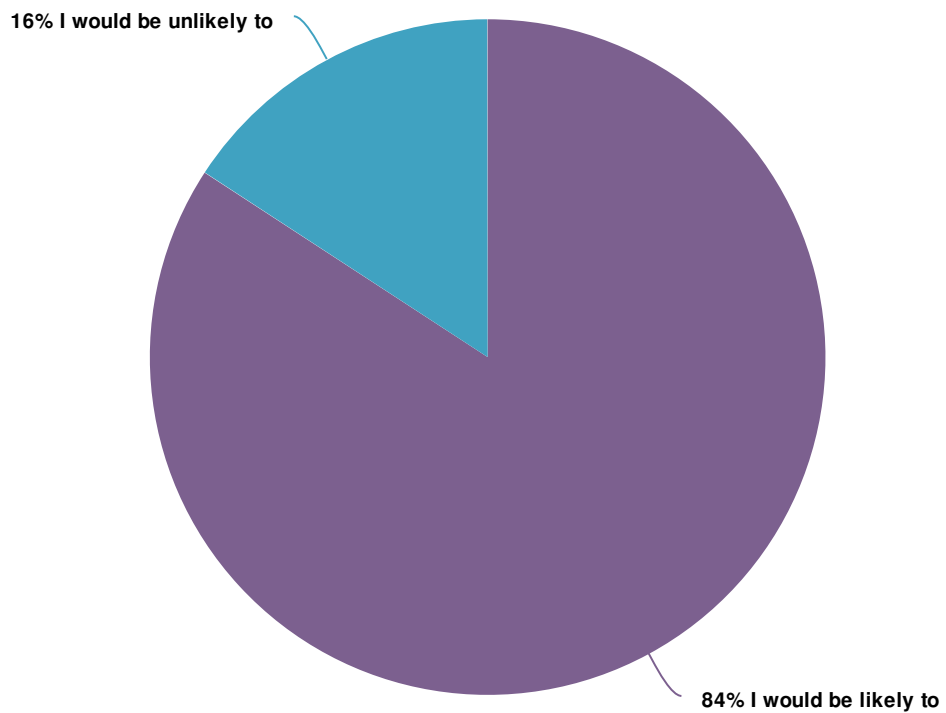


Would you know how to? - Seek medical attention at a local hospital or clinic

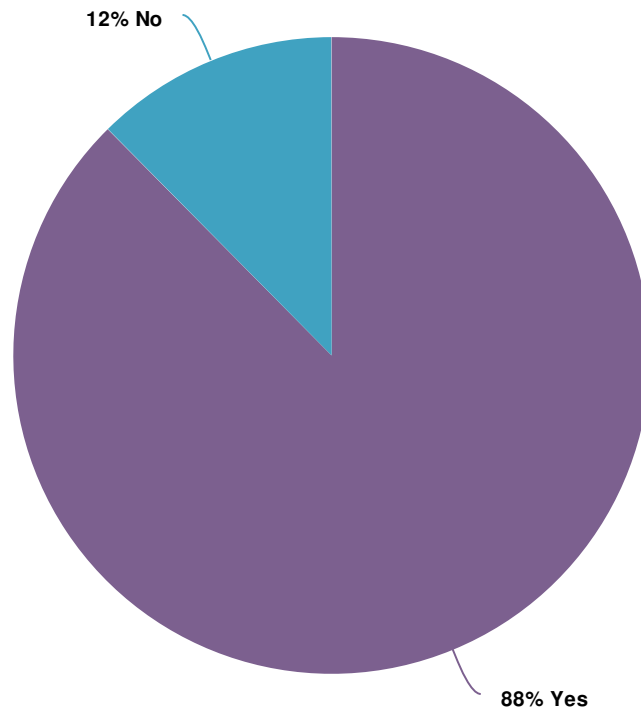
62. Are you aware that the CIA has a designated Title IX Coordinator who ensures cases of sexual misconduct are properly documented, investigated, and adjudicated?
